




# Why is research important?

With **diverse participation**, research discoveries can have a greater impact and benefit a broader range of people.



### What you should know:

### Your participation is voluntary

- You do not have to participate if you do not want to.
- You can withdraw from the study at any time.
- If you do not participate or if you withdraw, you will still continue to receive the medical care or other services to which you are entitled or may be receiving.

### Your privacy is protected

- ✓ Your rights to privacy are legally protected by federal and provincial laws that require safeguards to ensure that your privacy is respected.
- Your identity and information remains with the research team only and no information that discloses your identity will ever be published without your consent.

## Your consent is needed!



Signing the **consent form** means you are willing to participate in the research, but you are still **free to** withdraw at any time. You do not give up any of your legal rights.

We value <u>transparency and integrity</u>. Before signing the consent form, the research team will make sure:

- 1 You understand what the research is **trying to achieve** and what you will be asked to do.
- You understand any possible risks and benefits associated with your participation.
- You have the chance to ask questions and that all your questions are answered.
