**DO THEY HAVE TROUBLE LEARNING MOTOR-BASED TASKS?
(USING A FORK, COLOURING, THROWING/CATCHING A BALL,
PLAYING ON THE PLAYGROUND)**

We are seeking children age 3-5 years of age with diagnosed or suspected Developmental Coordination Disorder (DCD) to participate in a Magnetic Resonance Imaging study (MRI).



Participants will receive **10 weeks of free occupational therapy** to work on child-specific motor goals. This specific therapy has been used in older children with DCD, but it is a new approach for children age 3-5 years.
